Land in farms

Decreased 6 percent from 55,097 acres in 1992 to 51,638 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 10 percent from 142 acres in 1992 to 128 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 14 percent from 191 farms in 1992 to 164 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

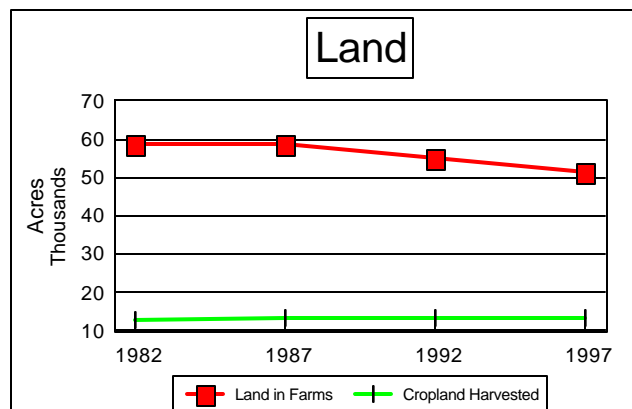
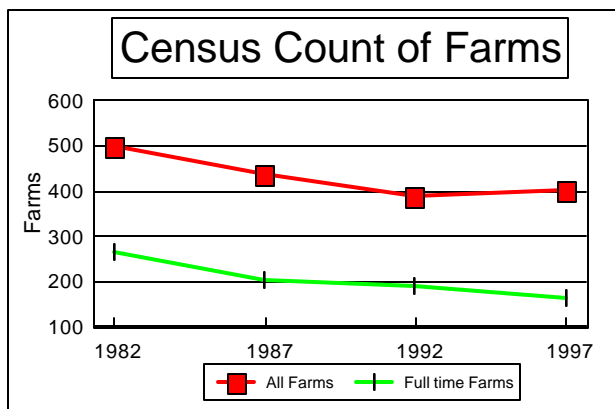
Decreased 9 percent to \$6,941,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 32 percent of the market value.
