Full time farms

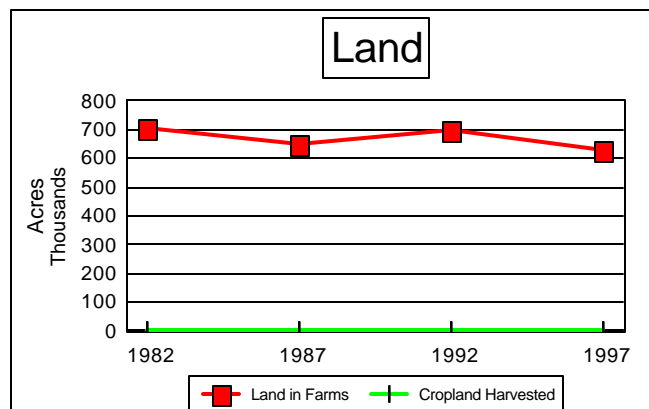
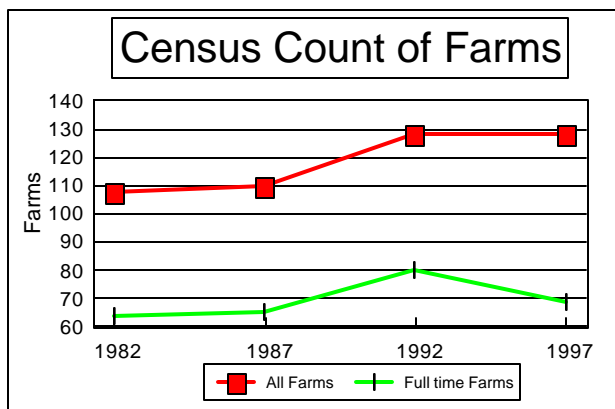
Decreased 14 percent from 80 farms in 1992 to 69 farms in 1997.
