Average size of farms

Decreased 3 percent from 757 acres in 1992 to 736 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 40 percent from 15 farms in 1992 to 21 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

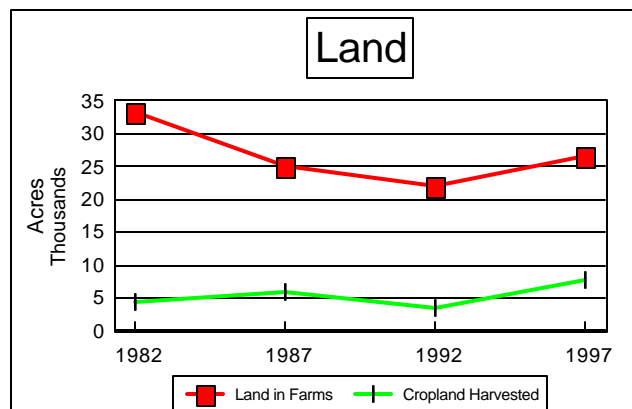
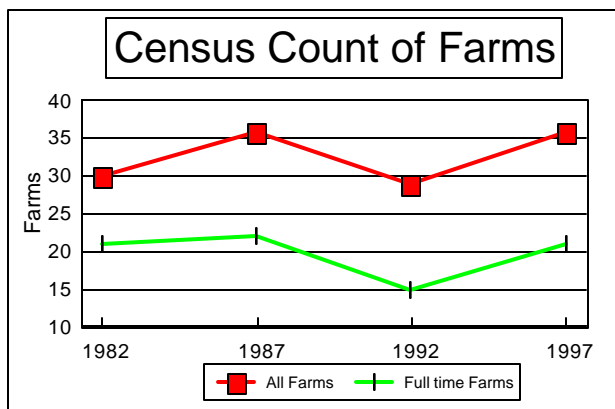
Increased 8 percent to \$1,440,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 30 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 70 percent of the market value.
