Average size of farms

Decreased 12 percent from 269 acres in 1992 to 237 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 5 percent from 278 farms in 1992 to 293 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

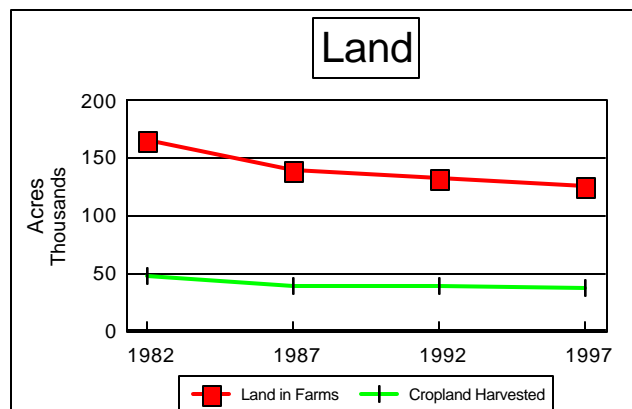
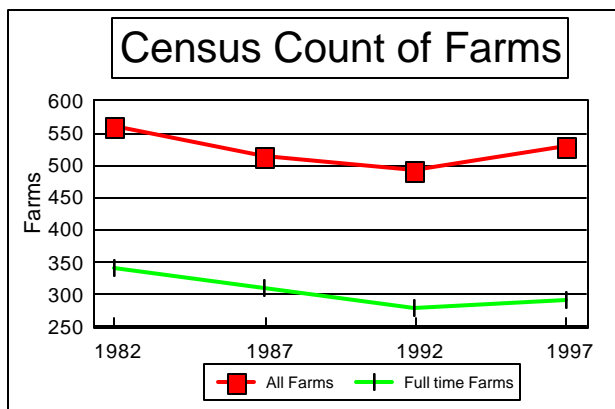
Increased 4 percent to \$28,357,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 11 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 89 percent of the market value.
