Increased slightly from 277 farms in 1992 to 279 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

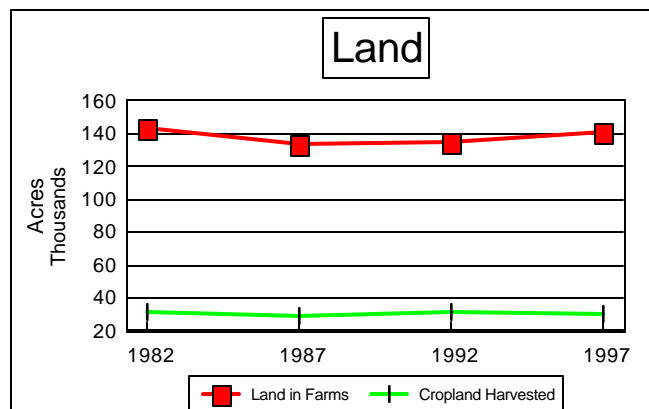
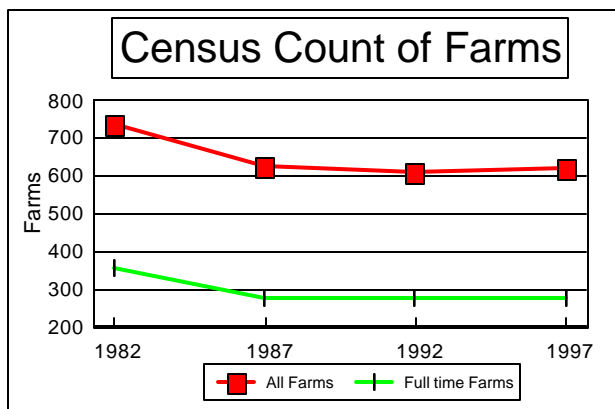
Decreased 2 percent to \$14,613,000 in 1997.
