Land in farms

Increased 15 percent from 101,214 acres in 1992 to 116,677 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased slightly from 161 acres in 1992 to 160 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 9 percent from 242 farms in 1992 to 263 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

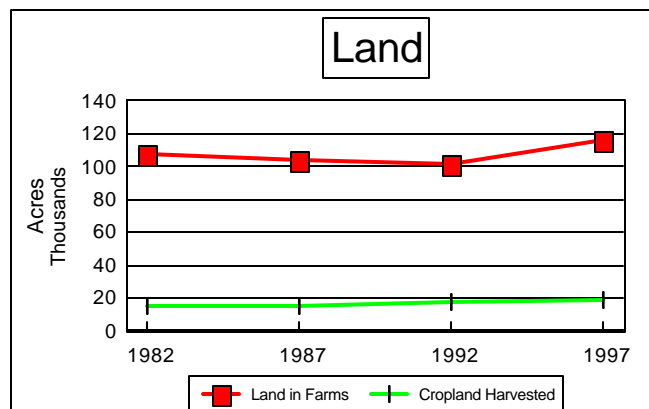
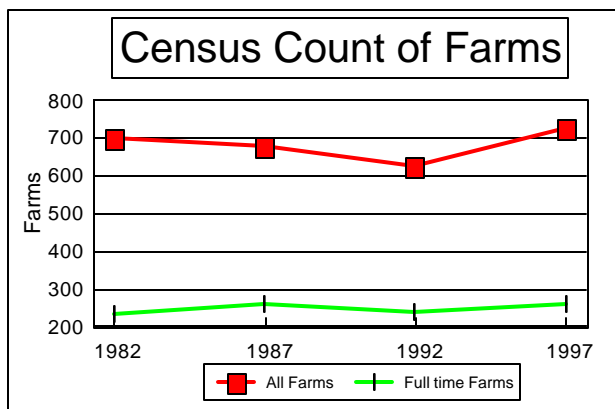
Increased 5 percent to \$4,362,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 30 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 70 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 9 percent from \$6,578 in 1992 to \$5,975 in 1997.
