Decreased slightly from 231 acres in 1992 to 230 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 29 percent from 473 farms in 1992 to 338 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

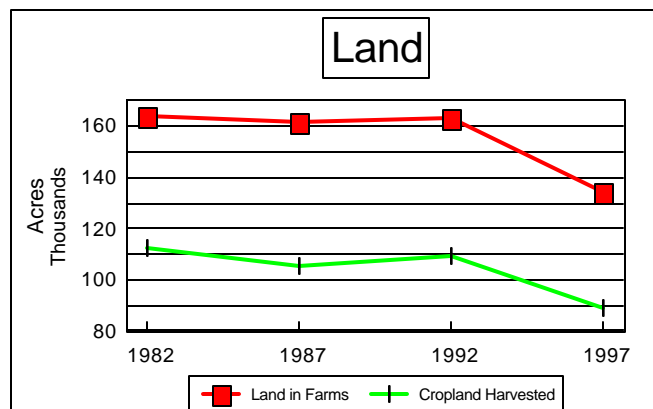
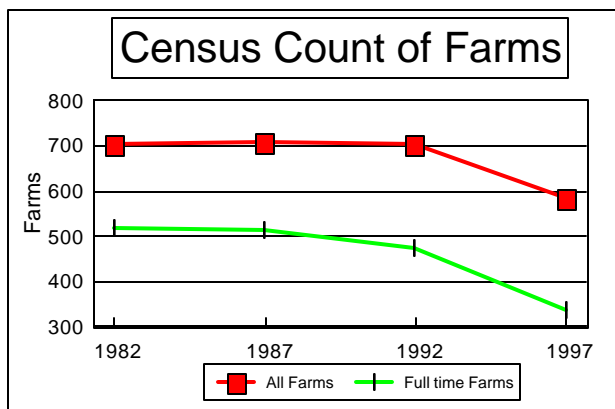
Decreased 19 percent to \$45,256,000 in 1997.
