Market value of agricultural products sold

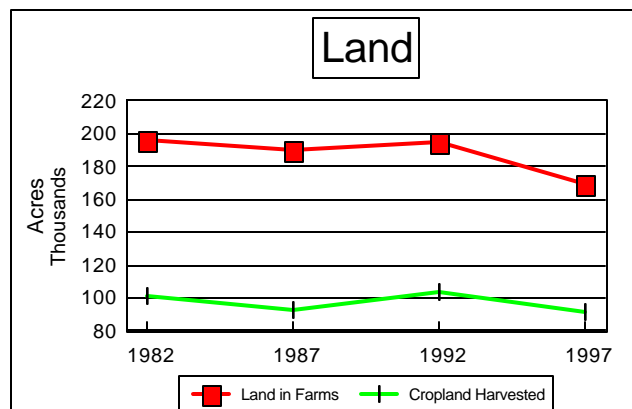
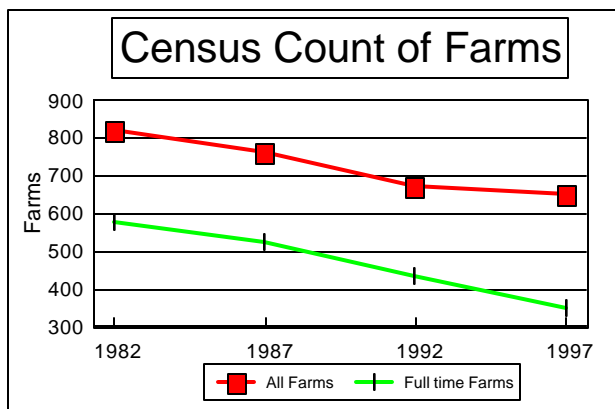
Decreased 6 percent to \$52,541,000 in 1997.
