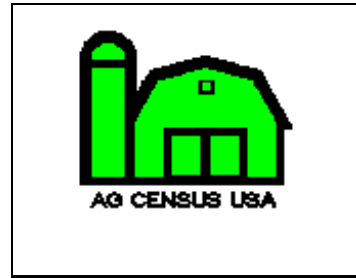

Land in farms

Decreased 5 percent from 170,228 acres in 1992 to 161,268 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 6 percent from 191 acres in 1992 to 203 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 19 percent from 647 farms in 1992 to 526 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

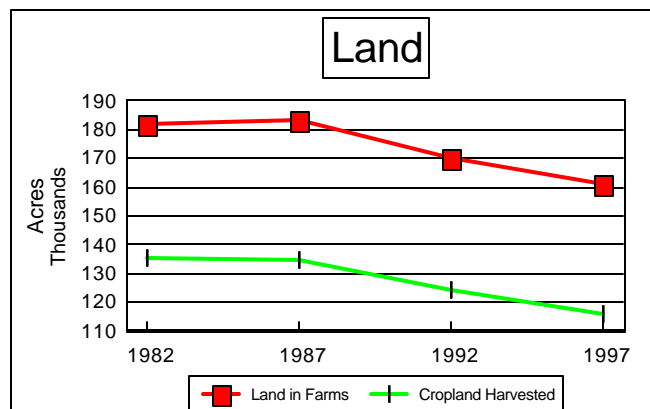
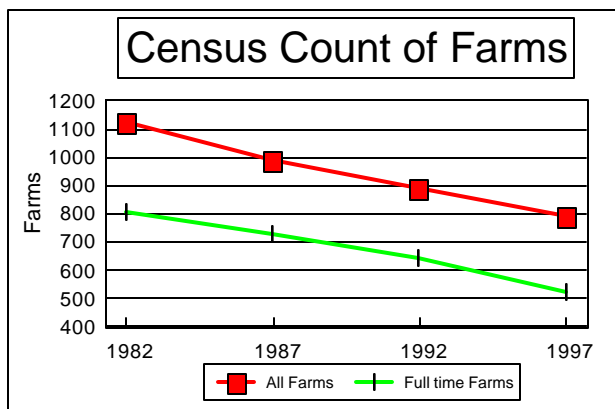
Increased 1 percent to \$80,730,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 19 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 81 percent of the market value.
