Increased 35 percent from 48 farms in 1992 to 65 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

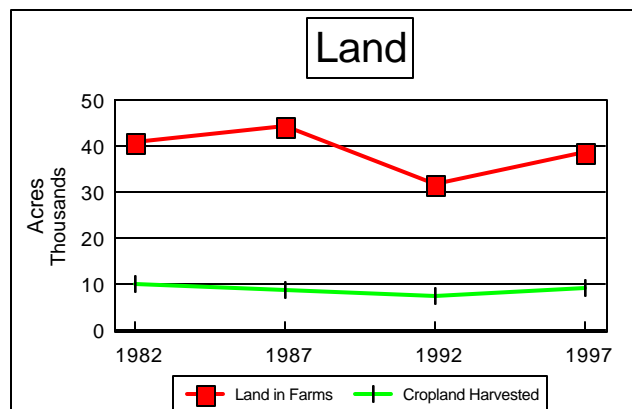
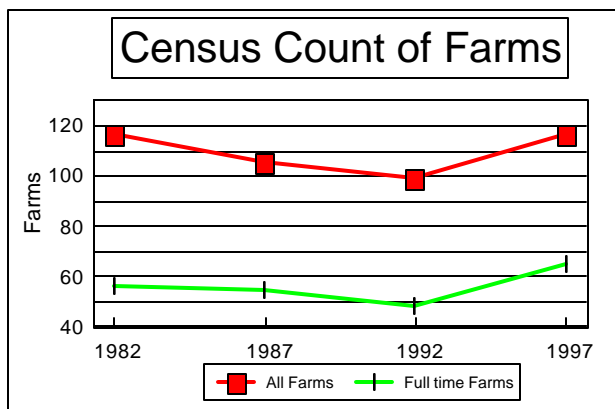
Increased 71 percent to \$13,290,000 in 1997.
