## WINNEBAGO WISCONSIN

### Land in farms

Decreased 1 percent from 169,876 acres in 1992 to 167,459 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 199 acres in 1992 to 195 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 10 percent from 551 farms in 1992 to 498 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

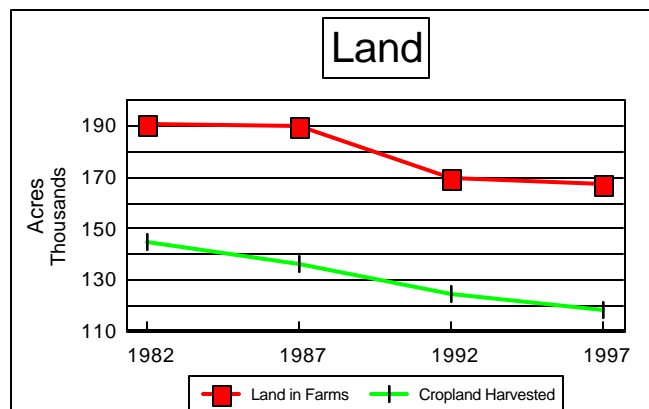
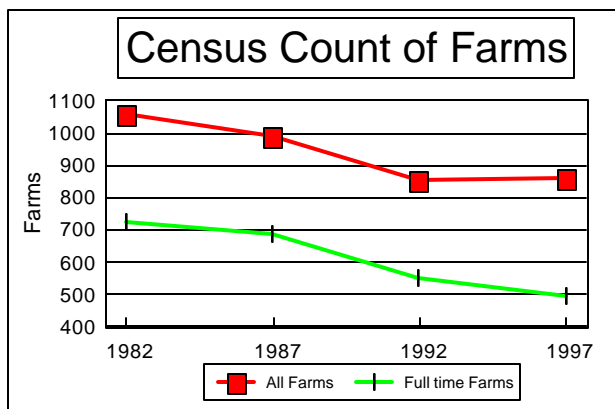
Increased 5 percent to \$61,689,000 in 1997.
