Decreased 21 percent from 601 farms in 1992 to 474 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

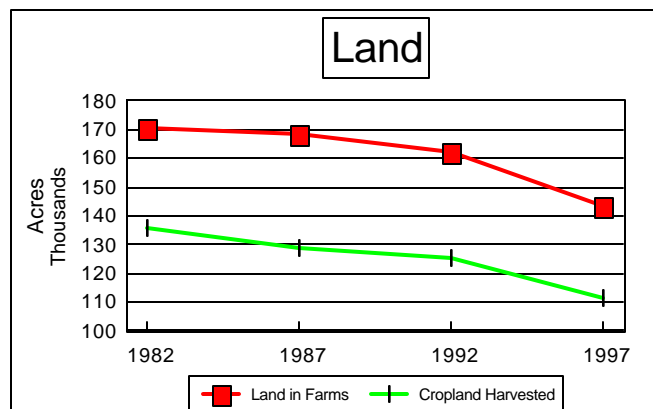
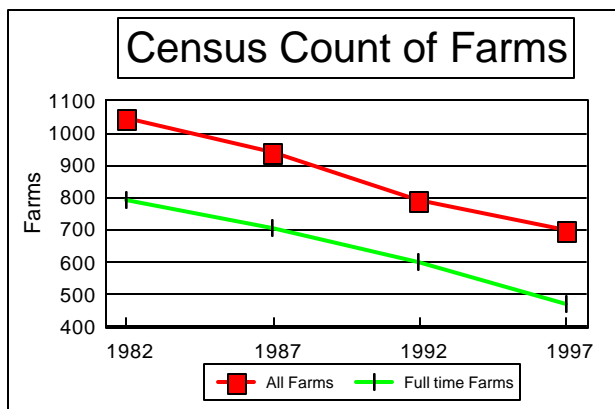
Decreased 2 percent to \$75,984,000 in 1997.
