## CAMPBELL WYOMING

### Land in farms

Increased 9 percent from 2,704,163 acres in 1992 to 2,943,628 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 5,681 acres in 1992 to 5,544 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 323 farms in 1992 to 317 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

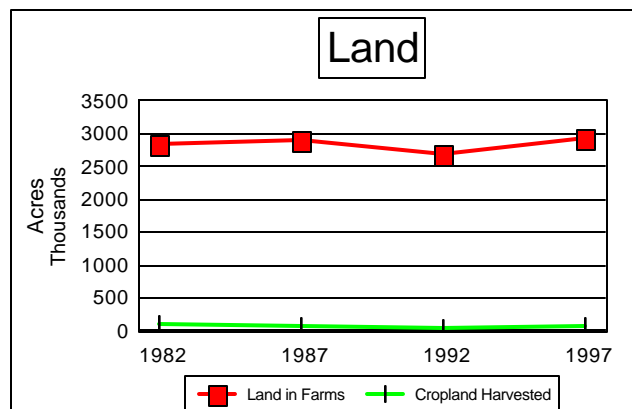
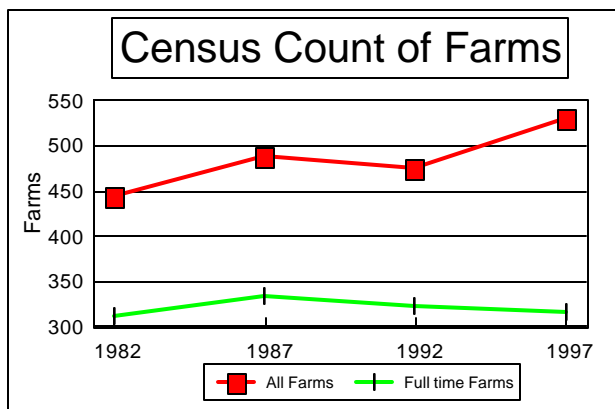
Increased 9 percent to \$34,924,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 6 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 94 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 2 percent from \$67,178 in 1992 to \$65,770 in 1997.
