

742 acres in 2002, 1,203 acres in 1997, down 38 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$19,975,000 in 2002, \$24,346,000 in 1997, down 18 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$15,218,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$4,757,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$44,588 in 2002, \$84,536 in 1997, down 47 percent.


Government Payments
