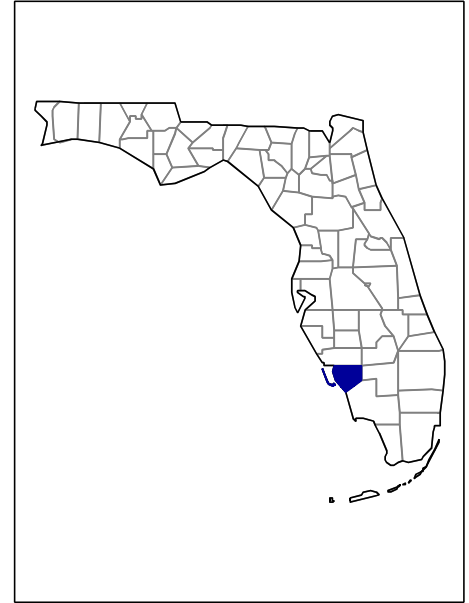

Market Value of Production, average per farm

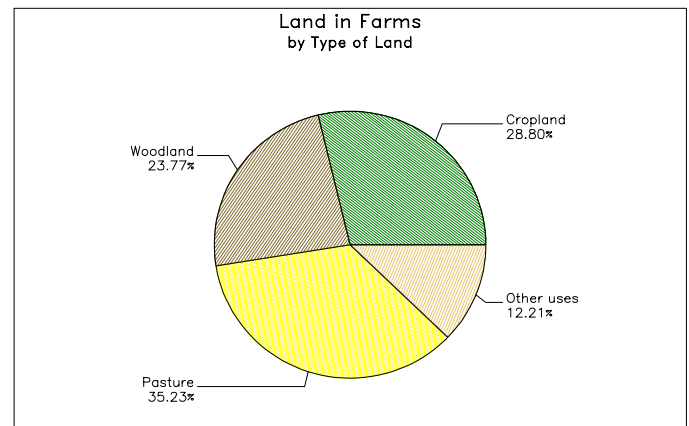
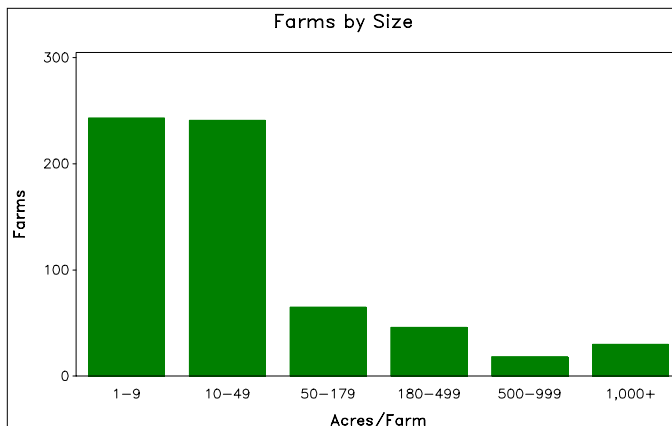
\$176,370 in 2002, \$162,726 in 1997, up 8 percent.
