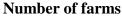

Market Value of Production, average per farm






\$298,000 in 2002, \$178,000 in 1997, up 67 percent.
