

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$154,661,000 in 2002, \$148,555,000 in 1997, up 4 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$66,407,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$88,253,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$184,780 in 2002, \$159,736 in 1997, up 16 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
