

\$41,980,000 in 2002, \$55,021,000 in 1997, down 24 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$14,418,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$27,563,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$53,275 in 2002, \$68,519 in 1997, down 22 percent.


Government Payments
