

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$204,312,000 in 2002, \$185,038,000 in 1997, up 10 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$82,644,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$121,668,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$205,752 in 2002, \$183,025 in 1997, up 12 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
