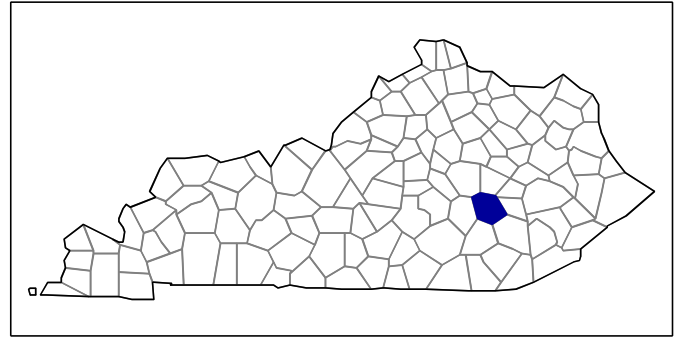

Market Value of Production, average per farm

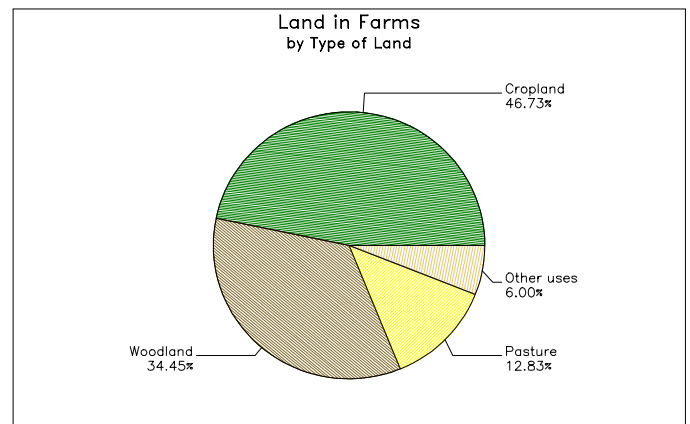
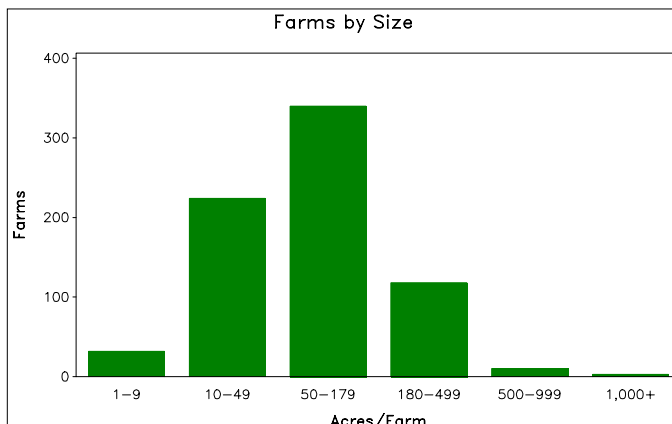
\$10,866 in 2002, \$13,218 in 1997, down 18 percent.
