

321 farms in 2002, 383 farms in 1997, down 16 percent.

30,032 acres in 2002, 35,274 acres in 1997, down 15 percent.

94 acres in 2002, 92 acres in 1997, up 2 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$3,244,000 in 2002, \$7,677,000 in 1997, down 58 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$2,837,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$407,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$10,105 in 2002, \$20,044 in 1997, down 50 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
