\$58,382,000 in 2002, \$51,190,000 in 1997, up 14 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$39,765,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$18,618,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm






