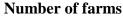

Market Value of Production, average per farm






\$1,185,000 in 2002, \$530,000 in 1997, up 124 percent.
