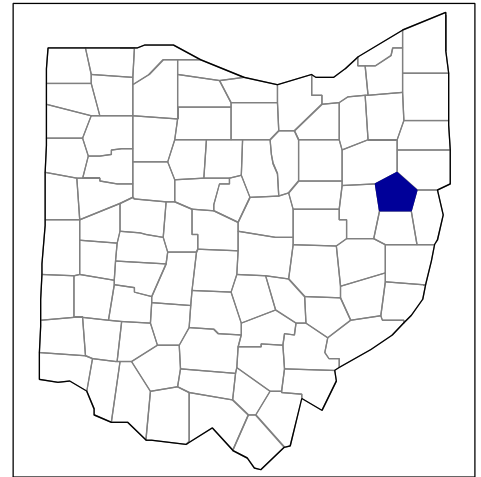

Market Value of Production, average per farm

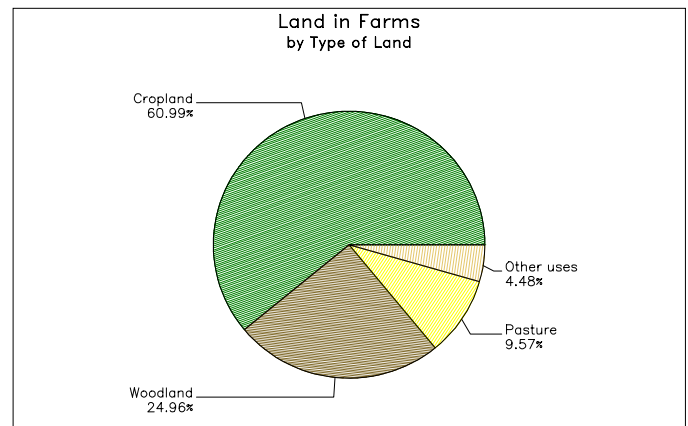
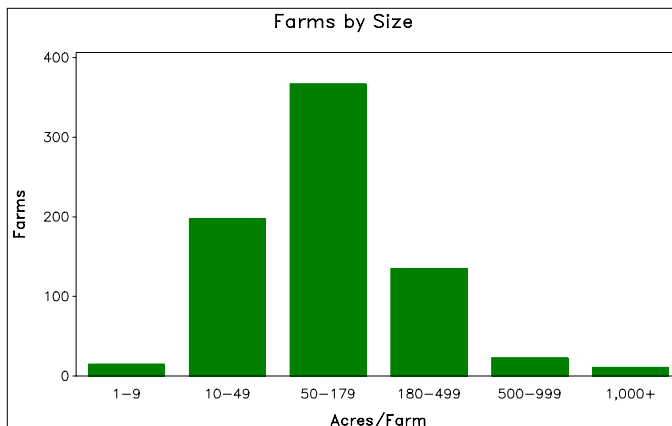
\$31,085 in 2002, \$26,093 in 1997, up 19 percent.
