

Market Value of Production

\$32,892,000 in 2002, \$32,850,000 in 1997, up slightly. Crop sales accounted for \$8,279,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$24,613,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$27,687 in 2002, \$28,222 in 1997, down 2 percent.


Government Payments
