

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$26,137,000 in 2002, \$34,587,000 in 1997, down 24 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$6,770,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$19,366,000 of the total value in 2002.

# Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$33,768 in 2002, \$44,457 in 1997, down 24 percent.


## **Government Payments**
