

\$54,665,000 in 2002, \$40,446,000 in 1997, up 35 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$2,251,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$52,415,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$57,241 in 2002, \$41,062 in 1997, up 39 percent.


Government Payments
