

\$35,179,000 in 2002, \$24,582,000 in 1997, up 43 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$8,608,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$26,571,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$34,762 in 2002, \$27,072 in 1997, up 28 percent.


