


# **2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile**

1,268 farms in 2002, 1,275 farms in 1997, down 1 percent.

288,969 acres in 2002, 313,145 acres in 1997, down 8 percent.

228 acres in 2002, 246 acres in 1997, down 7 percent.

### **Market Value of Production**

\$14,607,000 in 2002, \$19,243,000 in 1997, down 24 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$2,835,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$11,772,000 of the total value in 2002.

# Market Value of Production, average per farm




# **Government Payments**
