

\$62,550,000 in 2002, \$103,312,000 in 1997, down 39 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$4,344,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$58,207,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$44,049 in 2002, \$75,965 in 1997, down 42 percent.


Government Payments
