

\$77,215,000 in 2002, \$79,753,000 in 1997, down 3 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$18,757,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$58,458,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$93,594 in 2002, \$85,389 in 1997, up 10 percent.


Government Payments
