

310,415 acres in 2002, 321,404 acres in 1997, down 3 percent.

Average size of farm

172 acres in 2002, 194 acres in 1997, down 11 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$25,957,000 in 2002, \$27,472,000 in 1997, down 6 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$4,571,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$21,386,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$14,397 in 2002, \$16,609 in 1997, down 13 percent.


Government Payments
