

\$25,213,000 in 2002, \$39,583,000 in 1997, down 36 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$4,780,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$20,433,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$20,026 in 2002, \$30,239 in 1997, down 34 percent.


Government Payments
