

1,179 acres in 2002, 1,262 acres in 1997, down 7 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$662,508,000 in 2002, \$668,743,000 in 1997, down 1 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$53,388,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$609,120,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$661,186 in 2002, \$758,212 in 1997, down 13 percent.


Government Payments
