

# Wallowa, Oregon

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$20,775,000 in 2002, \$27,322,000 in 1997, down 24 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$7,077,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$13,699,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$41,303 in 2002, \$53,052 in 1997, down 22 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
