

\$208,558,000 in 2002, \$167,578,000 in 1997, up 24 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$171,920,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$36,638,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$89,548 in 2002, \$77,048 in 1997, up 16 percent.


Government Payments
