Crop sales accounted for \$202,568 of the total value in 2002.

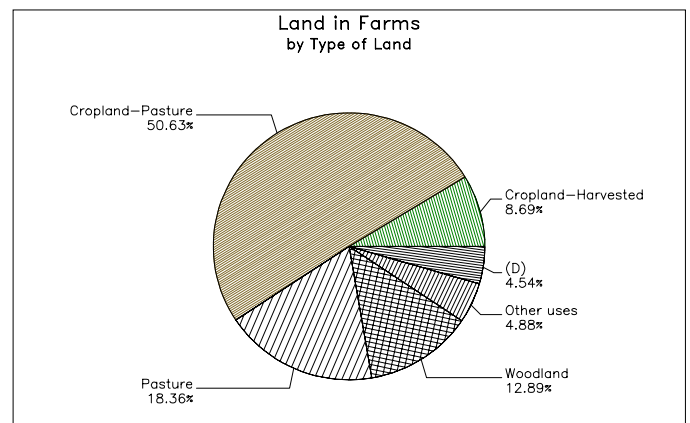
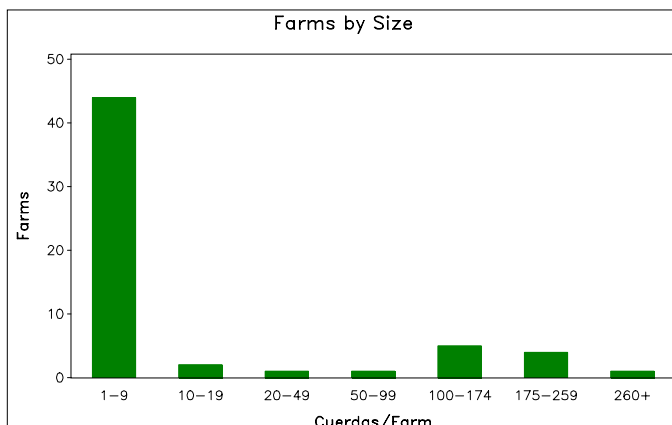
