Crop sales accounted for \$1,921,065 of the total value in 2002.

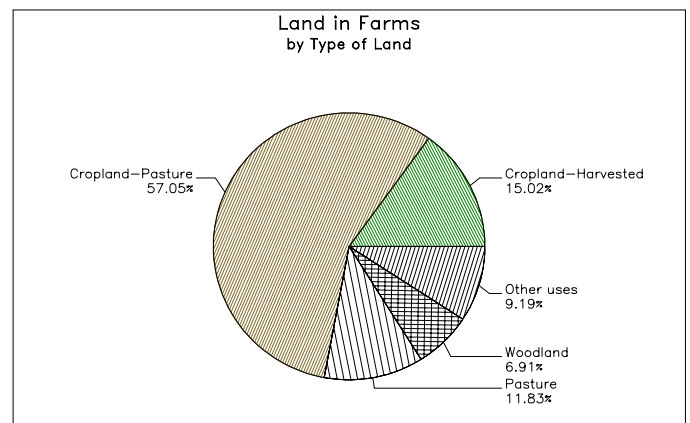
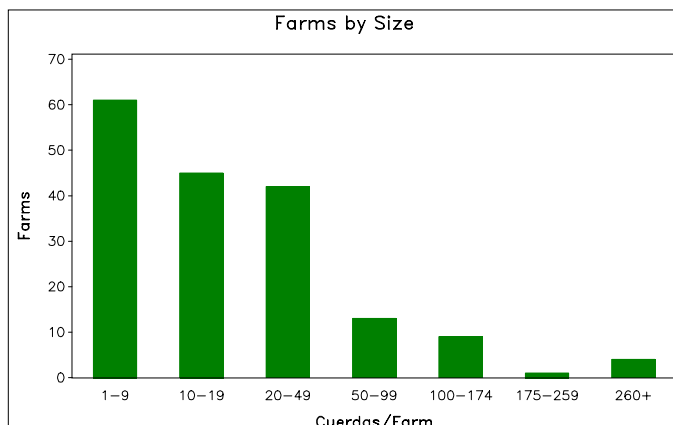
