Crop sales accounted for \$2,697,520 of the total value in 2002.

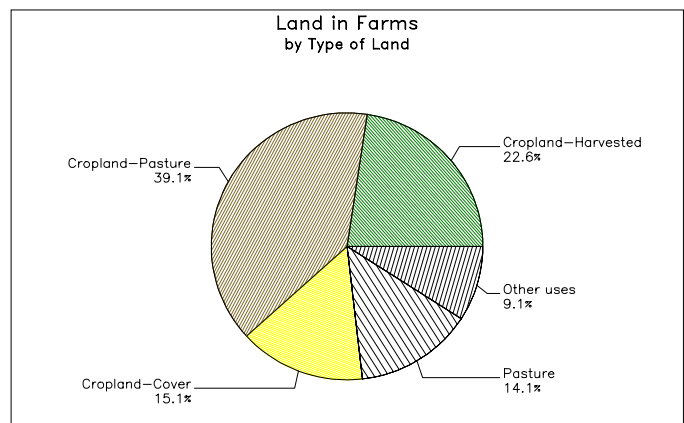
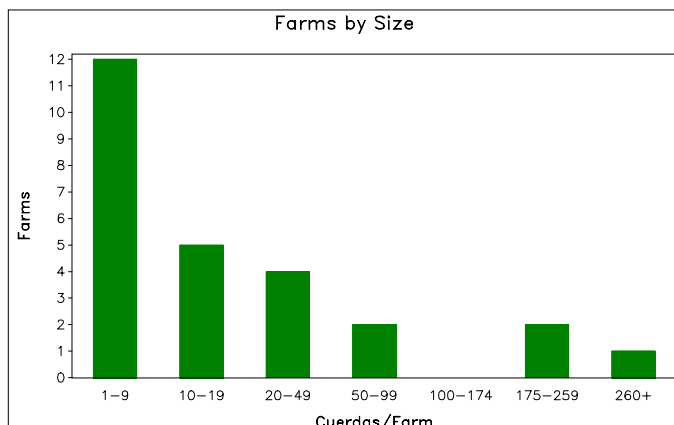
Livestock sales accounted for \$247,238 of the total value in 2002.
