Crop sales accounted for \$821,689 of the total value in 2002.

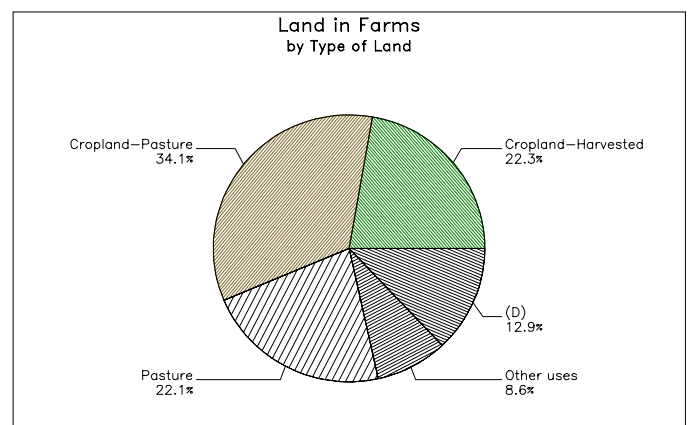
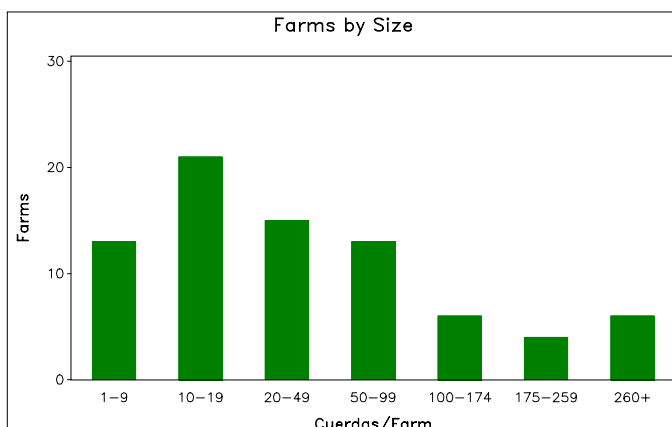
