Crop sales accounted for \$536,721 of the total value in 2002.

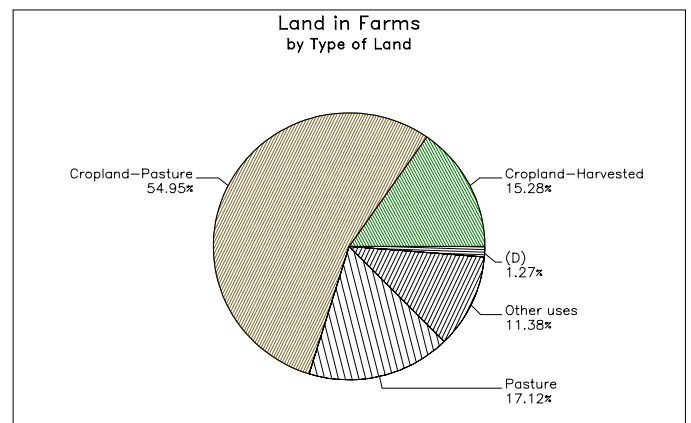
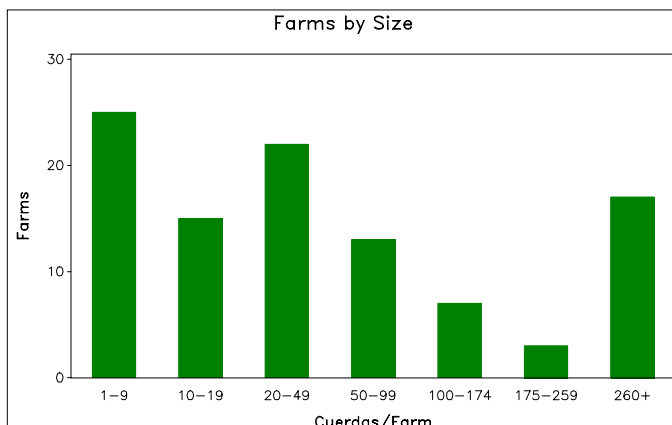
Livestock sales accounted for \$8,102,458 of the total value in 2002.
