### Market Value of Production, average per farm

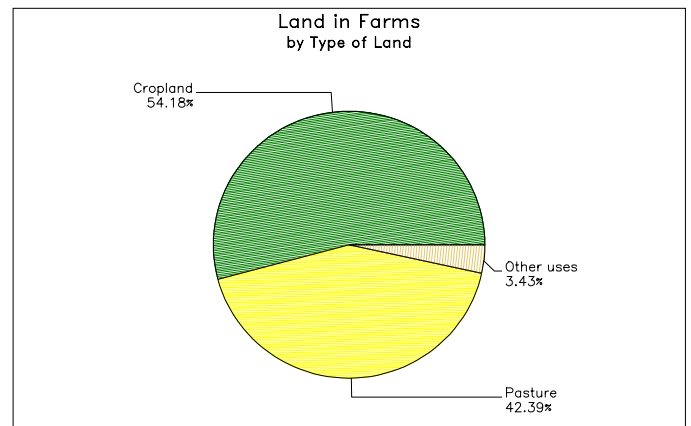
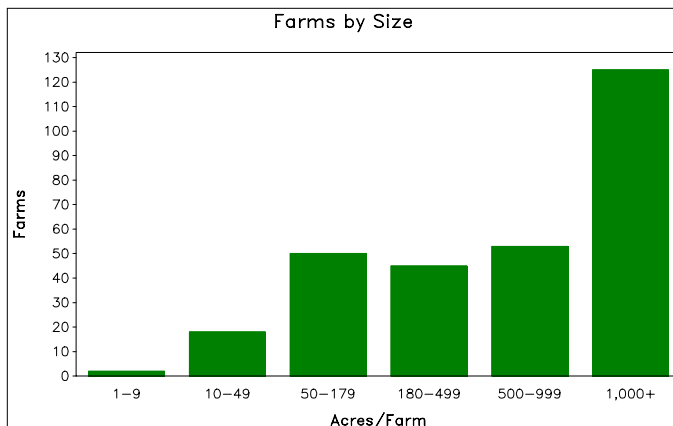
\$86,518 in 2002, \$108,253 in 1997, down 20 percent.
