

# Crockett, Tennessee

#### **Number of farms**

420 farms in 2002, 459 farms in 1997, down 8 percent.

145,091 acres in 2002, 161,162 acres in 1997, down 10 percent.

#### Average size of farm

345 acres in 2002, 351 acres in 1997, down 2 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$35,110,000 in 2002, \$50,795,000 in 1997, down 31 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$33,571,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$1,539,000 of the total value in 2002.

#### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$83,595 in 2002, \$110,665 in 1997, down 24 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
