

\$4,350,000 in 2002, \$4,570,000 in 1997, down 5 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$1,532,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$2,818,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$9,932 in 2002, \$8,672 in 1997, up 15 percent.


Government Payments
