

# Jefferson, Tennessee

#### **Number of farms**

1,311 farms in 2002, 1,324 farms in 1997, down 1 percent.

#### Land in farms

107,703 acres in 2002, 103,983 acres in 1997, up 4 percent.

### Average size of farm

82 acres in 2002, 79 acres in 1997, up 4 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$23,038,000 in 2002, \$20,341,000 in 1997, up 13 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$3,814,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$19,224,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$17,573 in 2002, \$15,364 in 1997, up 14 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
