

\$20,237,000 in 2002, \$16,192,000 in 1997, up 25 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$13,658,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$6,579,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$14,353 in 2002, \$11,045 in 1997, up 30 percent.


Government Payments
