

\$21,547,000 in 2002, \$23,123,000 in 1997, down 7 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$1,901,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$19,646,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$78,640 in 2002, \$74,592 in 1997, up 5 percent.


Government Payments
