

69 acres in 2002, 60 acres in 1997, up 15 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$22,604,000 in 2002, \$18,940,000 in 1997, up 19 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$5,755,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$16,849,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$15,557 in 2002, \$12,002 in 1997, up 30 percent.


Government Payments
