


# **2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile**

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$13,232,000 in 2002, \$14,163,000 in 1997, down 7 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$2,226,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$11,006,000 of the total value in 2002.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$140,767 in 2002, \$136,185 in 1997, up 3 percent.


### **Government Payments**
