


# **2002 Census of Agriculture County Profile**

## Jefferson, West Virginia



#### **Number of farms**

474 farms in 2002, 440 farms in 1997, up 8 percent.

#### Land in farms

71,880 acres in 2002, 74,533 acres in 1997, down 4 percent.

#### Average size of farm

152 acres in 2002, 169 acres in 1997, down 10 percent.

#### **Market Value of Production**

\$17,341,000 in 2002, \$19,473,000 in 1997, down 11 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$7,118,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$10,223,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$36,584 in 2002, \$44,257 in 1997, down 17 percent.


#### **Government Payments**
